 - Daria Isupov (RRWA) announced that two projects submitted by RRWA member agencies have been included on the Priority Projects list for the inclusion in the Prop 84, IRWM Program 2014 Drought Grant application.
 - The non-adopted version of the North Coast IRWM Plan, Phase III is available for public review (June18 - July 18).
 - Final Groundwater Basin Prioritization Results for the CASGEM program are now available. Basin Prioritization is being used to align resources in the implementation of the CASGEM Program.

- Jenifer Piccinini (Santa Rosa) introduced herself as the new staff coordinator for Creek Week. She requested that other agencies provide their planned activities for inclusion in Santa Rosa's outreach efforts. Jenifer Piccinini said that the 2014 Creek Week will take place from Sept 20-27 and summarized the planned activities.
- Heaven Moore (Santa Rosa) asked if other agencies have experienced issues
 with private developers who cannot purchase storm drain decals. The Cityrecommended vendor recently stopped selling decals and developers cannot
 comply with permit requirements if decals are not available and that the City
 cannot sell them. Lisa Steinman (SCWMA) offered to contact SCWMA's vendor
 to seek a solution.
